

Dear Parish Family,

In our Wednesday night book club we read that "any kind of work is God's work." There were numerous examples of our community coming together to do God's work in the last month. We spent dozens of hours preparing for our upcoming Festival, expanded our homeless ministry into the month of June, hosted another pop-up food pantry, and launched our Summer Sunday School program, just to a name a few!

All these tasks show our love for the Lord and His Church. But most significantly, we gather together to do His work and show our love for Him in our worship. Numerous Saints are commemorated in the month of July. This means that there will be many opportunities to attend weekday Liturgies in addition to our Sunday worship. We celebrate these services to remember and call upon the Saints, whose prayers on our behalf are very powerful.

On July second the Church commemorates Saint John Maximovitch, Archbishop of Shanghai and San Francisco. Many miracles have been attributed to the prayers of Saint John. Although some may have heard my family's personal story of St. John's intercessions, I would like to share it again.

In the spring of 2013, about five and a half weeks before her projected due date, Presvytera Gabrielle and I learned that the baby she was carrying had stopped developing in her womb. She was immediately admitted to the hospital so that labor could be induced. After the medicine was administered, a physician came to prepare us for what to expect after Peter was born. We were assured he would survive, but we were also assured that he would begin his life with tubes for breathing, eating, circulation, and would need six weeks in an incubator.

While we waited a fellow seminarian came with Holy Oil from a Saint that, up until then, my family and I were only somewhat familiar with. Presvytera Gabrielle was anointed with oil from Saint John Maximovitch's Cathedral, as was Peter within seconds of his birth. We prayed and waited for her to deliver. Peter was born breathing just fine and screaming quite loudly, with his only issue being a low birth weight. Three weeks later, he was home with us. On July second of the same year, (The Feast of St. John), Peter's pediatrician told us that he could no longer be measured by premature birth standards. He was officially well within the range of a full-term baby.

Some of the hospital staff were puzzled by the difference between the diagnosis and Peter's condition at birth. For our family there was no question what had happened. God was, and may He continue to be, glorified through His Saints!
